# SHAMROCKS & TRADITIONS TOUR OF IRELAND 2019

## Thursday, August 15 – US to SHANNON

Depart the US for your non-stop overnight flight to Ireland.

## Friday, August 16 — SHANNON ARRIVAL & DONEGAL

After customs and immigration formalities, your CIE Tours driver/guide will welcome you to Ireland. Join a local guide for a gentle walking tour of Galway. See the medieval city walls, Lynch's Castle and the narrow streets. Continue on to visit the Belleek Pottery Factory to see how skilled craftspeople form and decorate clay to produce delicate porcelain masterpieces. Then drive to your hotel in Donegal and check in for your overnight stay. In the evening, join your fellow travelers for a welcome drink followed by dinner in the hotel restaurant.

## Saturday, August 17 - SLIEVE LEAGUE & HANNA HATS

Today, visit Hanna Hats, which is world famous for its tweed hats. The shop is also known for its woven wool & other fine apparel. Motor a short distance to visit Slieve League Sea Cliffs, where the highest point reaches 1,972 feet making them the highest in Europe. Have tea & scones while at the cliffs before traveling via Glengesh Pass back to Donegal. The remainder of the afternoon & evening is at leisure.

## Sunday, August 18 - GLENVEAGH NATIONAL PARK

Leaving Donegal, motor a short distance to visit Glenveagh National Park where high walls and conifers provide shelter for an amazing collection of exotic plants from all over the world. Visit Glenveagh Castle, a Scottish-style baronial mansion, which contains fine antique-filled rooms. Travel to Derry and join a local guide for a walking tour around the ancient city. See the Guildhall, St. Columb's Cathedral, the Diamond & the 16th century walls. Check into your hotel for dinner and your overnight stay.

## Monday, August 19 - DUNLUCE CASTLE & BELFAST

Travel just outside of Portrush & visit Dunluce Castle. This splendid structure sits on basalt rock jutting out over the sea, reached by a wooden walkway. During the 16th century it was home to the MacQuillans, and later the MacDonnells. Continue on to visit Bushmills Distillery, which is Ireland's oldest whiskey distillery. See how whiskey is distilled and try a sample! Motor a short distance to visit the Giant's

Causeway, an impressive area of hexagonal columns formed over 60 million years ago by cooling lava. Then drive to the bustling city of Belfast and check into your hotel. You may wish to relax or freshen up before dinner with your group.

## Tuesday, August 20 - BELFAST HIGHLIGHTS

Embark on a guided tour of Belfast to see the Albert Memorial, the Opera House & Crown Liquor Saloon. In Donegal Square view the imposing City Hall. Stop & visit Titanic Belfast to embark on a journey through the life of the Titanic, from her conception in Belfast to her tragic end. Visit Crumlin Road Gaol to explore over 150 years of Northern Ireland's dark history from, political prisoners to everyday citizens imprisoned during "the Troubles," many of which still live in Belfast to this day. The remainder of the day is free for individual pursuits and dining.

## Wednesday, August 21 - GLENDALOUGH

Stop to visit the 6th century monastic ruins of Glendalough. The visitor centre explains how St. Kevin founded this settlement at a time when Christianity was burgeoning throughout Ireland. Head to Dublin & check into your hotel. Once you settle in, you can sightsee and shop on your own.

This evening, drive to the Merry Ploughboy Pub for dinner followed by a lively show of traditional Irish songs, dancing and music.

## Thursday, August 22 - RETURN TO THE UNITED STATES

Transfer to Dublin Airport to check in for your flight. Enjoy last minute shopping at the duty free stores. Then clear U.S. Immigration before boarding your aircraft and flying westward to the United States.
